SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO FILL WARD 3 VACANCY

*Appointment of Alternate Person to Perform Election Duties*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma, Alabama (*hereinafter referred to as "City"*) will hold a Special Election on Tuesday, May 24, 2011 and if necessary a run-off election on Tuesday, July 5, 2011 to allow qualified electors within Ward 3 of the City to fill the Council seat that was declared vacant on January 11, 2011 upon resignation of its Councilwoman and passage of a resolution by the Selma City Council declaring the same; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City has certain duties to perform in conducting a Municipal Election under the laws and statutes of the State of Alabama; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has the authority under the laws and statutes of the State of Alabama to designate a disinterested individual to perform said election duties in his stead; *and*

**WHEREAS**, to avoid the appearance of impropriety, the Mayor desires the City Council to exercise its authority and appoint a disinterested individual to perform said election duties for the Special Election on Tuesday, May 24, 2011 and if necessary a run-off election on Tuesday, July 5, 2011.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama as follows:

Ivy Harrison, City Clerk of the City of Selma is hereby designated to perform the election duties required of the Mayor pursuant to the laws and statutes of the State of Alabama, during and for the Special Election on Tuesday, May 24, 2011 and if necessary for a run-off election on Tuesday, July 5, 2011.


