WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to apply for Official Recognition as a Weed and Seed Site, and


WHEREAS, Weed and Seed is a community-based strategy sponsored by the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), is an innovative, comprehensive multi-agency approach to law enforcement, crime prevention, and community revitalization; and

WHEREAS, Weed and Seed is foremost a strategy—rather than a grant program—that aims to prevent, control, and reduce violent crime, drug abuse, and gang activity in high-crime neighborhoods across the country. The more than 250 Weed and Seed sites range in size from several neighborhood blocks to several square miles, with populations ranging from 3,000 to 50,000; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Planning and Development, hereby request permission to use of \$2,500.00 from the Grant Application Preparation Line Item (1.6006 100.95) to enter into an agreement with a consultant to assist in preparation of the Application for Official Recognition as a Weed and Seed Site.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Selma hereby authorizes the use of \$2,500.00 from Grant Application Preparation Line Item (1.6006 100.95) to pay a consultant to assist in preparation of the Application for Official Recognition as a Weed and Seed Site, and does hereby authorizes James Perkins, Jr. in his capacity as Mayor to execute said agreement.


